1 in 5 people in England have an impairment or health condition

9.4 million disabled people



The prevalence of disability rises with age



5.0 million are over state pension age

6.0 million are adults of working age

0.9 million are children

In England, disability is more prevalent in women than men



Impairment Statistics

The following facts show the numbers of disabled people in the UK with different types of impairments.

of disabled people have more than one impairment

8.5
million

people in England have some sort of hearing loss (limiting and non-limiting)

Less than 8% of disabled people use wheelchairs across the UK.
That's around 1.2 million

There are 1.5 million people in the UK with sight loss that has a significant impact on their daily lives.
